Plan 1. One-price ticket (adult or child): only \$5. This includes admission to amusement park. We stamp your hand and away you go for all the rides you want from 10 a.m. to 10 p.m. And you can enjoy all of the live entertainment and shows on the Funway, in the Theaters and in Frontier Town. Use of the beach is included too!

Plan 2. Ten-ride ticket books (adult or child): only \$4.
